C.H. Spurgeon said, “We shall not greatly err, in our summary of this sublime Psalm, if we call it ‘The Psalm of Messiah the Prince’, for it sets forth in a wondrous vision the tumult of the peoples against the Lord’s anointed, the determinate purpose of God to exalt His own Son, and the ultimate reign of His Son over all His enemies.”

This morning we will consider 4 things in that regard ...

1) The Raging of the Nations, vs. 1-3

2) The Response of God to their raging, vs. 4-6

3) The Reign of the Son, vs. 7-9

4) The Recommendation of God to the Nations, vs. 10-12
